

TERMS & CONDITIONS

JUNIOR ART PRIZE 2026

- The theme this year is My Dream Toy.
- Registrations and artwork submissions close Friday 15 May 2026.
- Entry is open to all children currently living in Kalgoorlie and surrounding areas (100km radius) aged between 4 and 12 years.
- Entry into the Junior Art Prize is free of charge.
- Only original artwork created by the entrant will be accepted. The artist must not infringe the copyright or other rights of any third party. Copying an artwork, photograph or an image from internet or printed publication created by another person is not permitted and such artwork will be removed from the Junior Art Prize. AI is not allowed.
- All artwork entries must be made on the Goldfields Art Centre specially-designed frame paper.
- Open to all mediums, including 2D and 3D. All produced works are required to be created on the Goldfields Arts Centre specially-designed frame paper.
- Artworks that are deemed not to belong to or be created by the entrant will NOT be eligible.
- Artwork containing photography of children is not permitted.
- Licensing the artwork: Entrants grant the Goldfields Arts Centre and all parties related to this project non-exclusive rights to photograph and reproduce their work, publish and/or communicate it to the public for the project related purposes, use it for marketing, publicity and education in all media, including but not limited to electronic/digital, broadcasting and print media.
- Goldfields Arts Centre will take photographs at the Award event that will be shared on Goldfields Arts Centre and external media channels for promotional purposes.
- Children of Goldfields Arts Centre employees, volunteers and children of judges are permitted to enter but are ineligible to receive any prizes.
- Prizes are not transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash.
- Winning artists don't need to be present at the awards afternoon to receive prizes. In the event of the winning artists being absent from the awards afternoon the prizes must be collected from the Box Office of the Goldfields Arts Centre before Monday 1 June 2026, 10am - 3pm.
- A completed Artist Entry Form including Artist Statement must accompany the artwork submitted.
- Consent form must be signed by the entrant's parent/guardian.
- All entries must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition.
- All work must be collected between Monday 29 June - Saturday 4 July 10am - 3pm weekdays and 10am - 1pm Saturday, unless prior arrangements have been made.
- All artwork not collected by Saturday 4 July will be disposed of.
